This survey asks about any delays to your care or treatment (following a referral by a GP). We are thinking about delays since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Changes to the ways people access health and care services

This survey asks about your thoughts on the different ways of accessing health and care services.

During the pandemic, new ways were introduced very quickly. These involved using technology, whilst we were locked down. Services are looking at how they can build on these changes for the future.



COVID-19 report

From May 2020 until January 2021, we ran our COVID-19 survey. This was followed by surveys about COVID vaccination and Test and Trace until April 2021.

We received over 900 survey responses altogether. Of these, 36% were completed on paper or by phone. Thank you if you helped with this work. It is important to us that everyone has a chance to have their voice heard.

Lung health check

More than 58,000 people aged from 55 to under 75 in Tameside and Glossop will be invited to a lung health check by their GP, and over 65% will be eligible for an appointment based on their smoking history. Over two years, this will identify an estimated 400 cases of lung cancer earlier than otherwise would have been.
